






Basic Info & Location Benefits

- Pomerania approx. 2,2 million people;
- In between End Markets in Western Europe, Scandinavia and CEE;
- Within 1,5 days distance by truck or ship, a circle of approx. 800 km around Pomerania, there are:
 Berlin, Copenhagen, Prague, Bratislava, Lviv, Minsk, Vilnus, Riga, Tallinn, Helsinki, Stockholm and Oslo;
- European Union member state (500 million people, free trade market no customs).









Sea Ports and Container Transhipments

- Tide- and ice-free all year-round;
- Over 1,9 m. TEU transhipped in 2014 2nd place in the Baltic Sea Region;
- Handling and storage facilities of all cargo;
- Four container terminals, including state-of-the art **Deepwater Container Terminal DCT Gdansk**;
- Target handling capacity: 6 mln TEU;

- **Terminals sevicing feeder connections:** Germany, the Netherlands, Russia, UK, Estonia, Latvia, Finland, Belgium, Spain;
- Port of call of all major shipping companies, including: CMA CGM, MSC, OOCL, Unifeeder, APL, Hapag-Lloyd, Hamburg Sud, Team Lines, Mannlies;
- Regular connections with major European hubs ensuring easy access to ports worldwide (Hamburg 5 times/a week, Bremerhaven 5 times/a week, Rotterdam 4 times/a week, Saint Petersburg 5 times/a week);
- Consistent investments in infrastructure.




- 5 weekly rail connections to the German hinterlands;
- Rail connections with all major Polish cities and inland terminals including Warsaw, Poznań, Wrocław, Kutno and Katowice;
- Inland terminals located in Ports of Gdansk and Gdynia serve approx. 1/3 of Polish intermodal transport.











Road Transport

Favorable location of Pomerania at the intersection of the two Pan-European Transportation Networks:

- IA Corridor linking Gdansk with Baltic countries;
- VI Corridor linking Nordic countries with South and Eastern Europe;

Most important routes:

- A1 Motorway (connects Pomerania with Czech Republic via Katowice);
- S7 Expressway (connects Gdansk with Warsaw);
- 6/S6 Expressway (connects Gdansk with Berlin).





Direct Flight Connections to All Major European Airports

- Lech Walesa International Airport serves connections with the most important European cities;
- Among all Polish airports, Gdansk offers the greatest number of air connections with the Scandinavian countries;
- Over three million passengers served in 2014;
- Over 50 direct connections including major European hubs such as Copenhagen, Munich, Frankfurt, Helsinki, Oslo.



- 3500 residents;
- Located by **National Road No. 22** (Berlin-Kaliningrad);
- Located by **Railway Line No. 203** (Tczew Piła);


